1: If you are in an online course contact your teacher

2: Send an e-mail to Mr. Gerber pgerber@sides.ca , Mrs. Harrison sharrison@sides.ca , Mr. Knapp hknapp@sides.ca or Mr. Surry csurry@sides.ca, Mr. Babcock kbabcock@sides.ca (for English and social studies)

3: Make a phone call in-town: **704-4936 or 704-4935**; out-of-town toll-free **(1-800-663-7610)**. The answering machine is on 24 hours a day, including weekends, so you may call it at any time! Tutors will respond as soon as possible.

3: Make an appointment to see a tutor. **Please call 704-4979 (front office) to set up your appointment.** This appointment can be to work with the tutor on-site or via computer in a Virtual Classroom (V-Class). If you cannot make an appointment you've made, please cancel so that others can use your time.

4: Drop in to one of our **Help Sessions for Math and Science**. We have four times available: Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 4-5pm and from 6 to 7 pm. No appointment necessary
