Transition To Adulthood (TTA) Program

SIDES is pleased to offer a unique program for students with diverse needs who have completed five or six years at secondary school and who require further assistance with their transition to adulthood. Eligible participants for the program must:

- be under 21 years of age;
- not have had a gap in school enrolment;
- have had an IEP in place during high school but not achieved all of the IEP goals; and,
- been on an Evergreen (modified) program.

Students that meet these criteria can apply to SIDES to become part of the TTA program. While in the program, students are supported in fulfilling unmet IEP goals; the support team consists of an Inclusion Support Teacher, a Course Teacher, and Educational Assistants.

SUPPORTING INCLUSION

Program opportunities are offered on an individual basis unique to each student and they are IEP driven. Through the TTA program, students will have access to some or all of the following opportunities as appropriate:

- access to the six on-line modified courses specifically developed for the TTA program and that focus on life skills and address IEP goals;
- planned programs on site at SIDES and in the community that enhance modified course curriculum and focus on IEP goals;
- work experience and job skill development to assist with transition planning;
- coordination of adult therapy services (OT, PT, SLP);
- coordination of outside agencies (for example, CLBC Facilitator, etc.) to create a transition plan;
- coordination of program development with support of the student's Home Facilitator;
- coordination with district specialists (for example, psychologists, district therapy teams from transitioning districts, etc.).
